Computerized Point of Sale System

- It is strongly recommended that all students remember their numbers, as this will make the meal lines move faster.
- Monies paid into a student account can only be used for the purchase of breakfast, lunch and/or snacks.
- **Parent/s can place restrictions/limits on accounts by calling 343-2480 ext. 1007 or email sslate@bataviacsd.org**
- With each prepayment of \$50.00 per student a free bonus lunch will be credited to their account.
- You can send in prepayment monies at any time to any building for any child. We recommend that parents send in checks rather than cash.
- Checks are to be made payable to Batavia City Schools.
- When sending a prepayment, please include the student's name or personal ID# on the face of the check. If you send in cash please indicate on the face of the envelope, the student's name or personal ID#.
- Secure online accounts and payments are available.
- Parents are encouraged to set up and sign up for electronic account management at: www.myschoolbucks.com **Toll free parent helpline for service: 1-855-832-5226**
- **FREE online access.** You can monitor you students account, check their purchases and sign up for low balance notice by email. You will need your student's ID# not their pin number they use in school.
- There is a \$1.95 fee for **each online prepayment transaction**. This is a fee for using online payments. This fee **DOES NOT** benefit Batavia City Schools. It is paid directly to the banks to cover the processing of the transaction. Again, one payment can cover multiple children; however you will need to identify each child and each allocation amount. To offset this fee, the District will credit a free lunch for each transaction of \$50.00 or more per student.
- Please visit the district website for frequently asked questions.
- Refunds will be rolled over for the next school year or rolled over to a sibling account. Only non-returning students are eligible for a refund.

Free/Reduced Meals (One application per family)



- Students participating in the Free/Reduced Price Meal Program are eligible for both breakfast & lunch.
- All current year applications are honored through **September 19**. A new application/ direct certification letter must be received by **09/19 of each school year** for meal benefits to continue.

- Applications are available in the A+ Communicator, the main office of each building & the district web site.
- Forms are available anytime during the school year. If you are not eligible now, but during the school have a decrease in household income, or an increase in family size, you may complete an application at that time.

Other Information

- The cost of breakfast and lunch is available on the district website.
- Please see the District Charge Policy located on the website and available in each Cafeteria.
- Menus are sent home monthly and are available on the district web site.
- Healthy snacks are available for purchase in the Cafeteria during lunch. Prices range from .05 – .75.
- Students allergic to milk may be served juice if the school nurse has received a physician script. **RENEW ANNUALLY.**
